Please encourage your students to dress appropriately for the weather and to come prepared for recess out in the cold. When kids have the right gear, they can have fun along with a well needed quick break outside, even when it's a little chilly out.

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GRADE LEVEL HIGHLIGHT: MUSIC

The Music Program is up and running full blast at Ridge View Elementary despite the challenges of a Pandemic. In Kindergarten we are exploring steady beat through movement songs, simple instruments and games. In first grade we are working hard on our Winter Musical Movie "The Wonders of Winter" which will premiere on December 14, 2020. Second grade has been playing Orff instruments and learning games to reinforce foundational music concepts. Third grade released Ridge View's first Musical Movie "Spooky Night" October 29th. The short musical presentation is being featured on Beverly Taylor Sorenson Arts online platforms and will be used along with the 1st grade's "The Wonders of Winter" to advocate for the program in the legislative session in January. The BTS Arts program funds the Arts in Utah schools. Third grade is now hard at work mastering their technique on Orff instruments as we transition to reading music on the treble clef staff. The fourth grade has been concentrating on mastering ostinatos independently and being able to layer their part into the music. Fourth grade will begin work on their upcoming Musical Movie celebrating the great state of UTAH to be presented in March. Fifth grade is focusing on American Folk Music and the history that created these wonderful songs that will culminate in our presentation of our American Musical Movie in April. Sixth grade has been focusing on challenging lessons that review foundation concepts.

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
