1. Welcome

- Voting Members Present: Kellie Mayne (Chair), Mayme Jackson (Vice Chair/Teacher), Molly Morgan (Principal), Anne Lewis (Council Member), Makayla Boyles (Council Member)

2. Safe Walking Routes

- SCC Training - "Safe Walk Routes to School" - Review existing routes and discuss areas of concern/proposed changes
 - Nathan Price reviewed the current Safe Walking Route in place and sought input from the School Community Council on the current plan.
 - Concerns and Requests:
 - Cars are not stopping at the stop sign at S Greenford Lane and Lower Meadow Drive despite a crossing guard stationed there. Last year a student was hit at this intersection. There was a request by Kellie to have more police presence.
 - It was recommended to start conversation with the city before the church is completed on Greenford Ln, across from the school. What recommendations does the city have to prevent families parking in the parking lot and walking across the middle of Greenford?
 - There was a request to double check that exit only signs are posted in the exit area of both parking lots.
 - Recommendation to paint a line in the bus zone on the

asphalt marking where the blacktop ends and bus lane begins.

3. School LAND Trust Plan

- Review current plan progress, data, and budget
 - Molly Morgan reviewed the Land Trust goal (**Acadience data will show a 2% growth in the number of students making typical or better progress by the end of the 2025-2026 school year**) and progress toward the goal. Acadience data was reviewed. The school is on track to meet the goal.
 - The SCC was pleased to see the progress.
 - Molly reviewed how Land Trust money is currently used
 - Literacy Coach
 - Portion of BTS Teacher salary
 - Rotation Assistants
 - Reading materials
- Discuss upcoming plan for 2026-27
 - Budget, academic goals, action steps
 - Molly reviewed the projected Land Trust budget for next year - \$125,355
 - Feedback and questions
 - Molly Morgan sought the SCC input on how to spend the Land Trust money next school year.
 - Kellie noted concerns that there is an emphasis on literacy and she is not seeing math homework or conversations about math from her child.
 - Makayla asked about data on student math levels. The principal said there is data and that she can put together data to review.
 - Mayme expressed support for the Literacy Coach and BTS Teacher
 - Kellie supports using the money for SEL instruction
 - Molly said she is interested in using the money for another kindergarten aide to support our 8 kindergarten classes
 - Molly will have a draft Land Trust plan for the next meeting for review and approval
 - Recommendations for TSSA Plan
 - Molly reviewed the current TSSA and TSI goal (same as

Land Trust goal)

- Kellie asked about assistants to support multilingual learners.
- Mayme recommended an assistant to support our multilingual learner students.

4. Mid-Year Elections

- Anne Lewis shared that she has moved outside the school boundaries. Also, Analia Delmoe has not attended a SCC meeting this year. Molly reviewed the Rules of Order and Procedure regarding these situations.
 - “8. Filling Vacancies: If a full council is not elected or if a seat becomes vacant, parent members of the council will appoint individuals to fill vacant parent positions, and school employee members will appoint individuals to fill vacant school employee positions.
 - 9. Removing Members: A council member may be removed from office under the following circumstances:
 - Member Relocation: Council membership may be discontinued when a member's relocation prevents them from serving on the council.
 - Attendance: The member fails to attend two consecutive regular council meetings without prior notification to and approval by the council chair.
 - The process for removal is as follows: If a member of the council meets the criteria listed above, the council will vote on whether to remove the member of the council. A majority vote in favor of removal will officially remove the member of the council...The procedure for filling the resulting vacancy is outlined in Section 8, 'Filling Vacancies.'
- Ana Rodriguez was recommended by Makayla.
- Kellie has a neighbour she will talk to.

5. Questions, Feedback, Agenda Items for Next Meeting (February 18, 2026)

- Kellie voiced concern that the school was an open campus. Molly said the district is looking at what it would take to close all campuses. The state legislature is considering laws regarding closed campuses.
- Kellie asked about emergency kits for classrooms. Molly reported that

three first aid kits will be delivered to the school. Kellie asked about buckets for the bathroom and snacks for students. Anne suggested we could ask parents for donations for snacks and buckets. Molly said that this will be agenda item for the next meeting.
