1. Welcome

2. School LAND Trust Plan

•Budget

- Mrs. Morgan reviewed the overall budget for 26-27 Land Trust.

•Proposed Plan/Goals

- Ms Morgan reviewed a proposed LAND Trust goal.
- Ms Morgan proposed a plan of how to use Land Trust Funds to reach the goal.

• Feedback/Concerns

- A motion was made by Kellie Mayne **to approve the Land Trust Plan** - second by Makayla Boyles.
- There was a discussion. The principal answered questions about hiring classroom assistants.
- The motion passed unanimously.

3. Discuss SCC Member Terms and Elections for 2025-2026

•New position

- There are two openings on the SCC due to one member moving and another member not being in attendance this school year. A call was sent out for the nominations last month. Danielle Dallof expressed an interest in being on the SCC.

- A motion was made by Makayla Boyles **to make Danielle Dallof a member of the Ridge View SCC**. A second was made by Mayme Jackson.
- After discussion, the motion passed unanimously.

•Unfilled position

- There is still one open position on the SCC. A call for nominations will go out again next school year.

4. Inclement Weather (Makayla)

- Makayla expressed concern that the current website used to pull weather data ([Weather Underground](#)) to determine an inside day is not displaying the correct weather at the school.
- She proposed using the weather data listed on the [Weather Channel website](#) with the Ridge View Elementary address when determining an inside day.
- Danielle Dallof made a motion **to use the weather data listed on the [Weather Channel website](#) with Ridge View Elementary address when determining an inside day**. There was a second by Kellie Mayne.
- After discussion, the motion passed unanimously.

5. Next Meeting: No more meetings for this school year

Other

- Makayla expressed concern with the KSL news report that a person with a gun was reportedly threatening someone by the school and asked why there was no lockdown called and why there was no information sent to parents. The principal and AP explained that they were in contact with Herriman PD regarding the incident who reported that there was no threat to the school. Admin contacted the district and it was determined, given the facts of the incident, information did not need to go out to parents.
- Kellie expressed concern about an incident where her child reported hearing another student use the n-word. The school administration is investigating the report and will take appropriate action.
