- Rules of Order and Procedure
 - 4 parent member council
 - In odd numbered years we will elect 3 vacant seats
 - In even numbered years we will elect 1 vacant seat
 - We will hold fall elections

- Review of Land Trust and TSSA Plans for current year (2023-24)
 - Plans are on our school website and can be reviewed at any time
 - Review of English Language Arts Goal (measured through Acadience data)
 - Review of Math Goal (measured through RISE data)
 - Review of Action Steps for ELA goal
 - ELA- Walk to Read literacy block 30 minutes each day, phonics and fluency interventions, enrichment activities for students on or above level
 - Intervention assistants
 - Rotation block for teacher collaboration, data analysis
 - Weekly PLC meetings
 - Review of Action Steps for Math goal
 - Similar to ELA action steps
 - Review of allocation and expenditures
 - Money for this year should be spent on students this year- the carry over should be under 10%
- Discussion about the focus on Language Arts and Literacy
 - Walk to Read is district wide
 - We are working towards state and district literacy goals
 - Focus on Language Arts addresses holes and gaps in literacy (some from Covid)
 - Science and Social Studies topics are integrated into Language Arts

- TSSA Plan
 - Goals are the same as Land Trust
 - Expenditures include instructional coaches
 - Mentor Program for new teachers (support and resources)
 - TSSA includes a “school initiative” goal- wellness center/calming kits
 - Wellness center focused on student mental/emotional wellness
 - Calming kits in each classroom
 - Teach students to regulate emotions
 - Playworks
 - Structured recess- focus on inclusion, rules, settling disagreements
 - Additional Support for teachers teaching English Language Learners
- Safe Technology and Digital Citizenship
 - Acceptable Use Policy- for all staff and students
 - Filters, alerts
